AN ORDINANCE FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF AN ALTERED SPEED ZONE

IT IS HEREBY DECLARED by the Board of Tazewell County, Illinois, that the basic statutory vehicular speeds limits established by Section 11-601 of the Illinois Vehicle Code are greater, or less than that considered reasonable and proper on the street or highway listed in the following schedule for which **Groveland Township Road District** has maintenance responsibility and which is not under the jurisdiction of the Department of Transportation, State of Illinois.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that this Board has caused to be made an engineering and traffic investigation upon the streets or highways listed in the Schedule; and

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that, by virtue of Section 11-604 of the above Code, this Board determines and declares that reasonable and proper absolute maximum speed limits upon those streets and highways described in the Schedule, shall be as stated therein.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that, by virtue of Section 11-604 of the above Code, this Board has reviewed the supporting data and findings of the engineering and traffic investigation for each proposed speed zone of said street or highway described in the Schedule, which is included as a part of this ordinance.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that signs giving notice of the proposed maximum speed limits for the zone or zones of said street or highway described in the Schedule shall be erected in conformance with the standards and specifications contained in the Illinois Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways.

BE IT FURTHER DECLARED that this ordinance shall take effect immediately after the erection of said signs giving notice of the maximum speed limits.

Background: Tazewell County entered into a delegation agreement with the Agency on August 31, 1998 and has received a local solid waste enforcement grant since SFY 1988. The current delegation agreement was renewed in June 2011 and will now expire on June 30, 2016. The County works with the Peoria Regional Office to implement this program. Mark Kimbrell was certified by the Agency in November 1991 and Russ Burcham was certified March 5, 2004. Ray Corey is also a certified inspector as of June 2004, and he manages this program. Gordon Poquette retired as Administrator on June 30, 2005. Amy Tippey replaced him as Administrator. Mark Kimbrell left county employment in October 20, 2009. Another inspector will be hired to train in SFY 2012.

Tasks: Conduct inspections at one active landfill, one active transfer station and one active compost site: Indian Creek Landfill #2; Tazewell Transfer Facility and Pekin Compost Facility. Inspect closed landfills: Indian Creek #1 (closed on January 11, 2001); Tazewell Recycling and Disposal Facility #1 and #2 (closed in December 2006) and Washington Landfill (closed in April 1994). Pckin Landfill is being inspected by Illinois EPA's Regional Office in Peoria. Extra work includes open dump and open burning complaint inspections and other enforcement grant activities as approved by the Agency. Total anticipated grant activities equal 101. The County does good work under this program.

#### AGREEMENT FOR COUNTY OF TAZEWELL

THIS AGREEMENT entered into by and between the County of Tazewell, Illinois, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", and G&B Mechanical, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", effective the 1st day of September, 2011.

WHEREAS, previous heretofore quotes were requested and received for the performance and completion of the replacement of three furnaces and air conditioning units in the Newlun Center Building; and

WHEREAS, the bid of G&B Mechanical was received and approved, subject to the execution of this Agreement by the parties hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the herein stated mutual covenants, promises and undertakings by the parties to this Agreement, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. The contract documents consist of this Agreement, contract drawings, specifications, and all addenda issued prior to the execution of this Agreement and all modifications subsequent thereto. These form the contract and are fully a part of this contract as if attached to this agreement or repeated herein. Additionally, and specifically, there is made a part of this Agreement the G&B Mechanical proposal dated May 24, 2011, all specifications contained therein, as well as all drawings contained or referred to in the above referenced manual, and all addenda and other documents incorporated in the above referenced contract documents.
- 2. The Contractor shall perform all work required by the contract documents as above described for the replacement of the HVAC systems as described in the above referenced contract documents and in accordance with the said documents, and it is contemplated that the work to be performed under this contract with Tazewell County, Illinois covers and includes, in general, the requirements for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, materials, and services and all other work associated therewith.
- a. Contractor shall provide the Sheriff with a list of its employees prior to any work being performed. The list shall provide the name, date of birth, social security number, and date of hire for each employee. Contractor shall immediately notify Sheriff of any additions or deletions to such list.

b.Contractor shall comply with all Tazewell County Security Procedures as established by the

Sheriff or Presiding Judge. Any breach of such security procedures shall constitute cause to terminate this agreement immediately.

- 3. It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that time is of the essence in the performance of the obligations required hereunder.
- 4. The consideration, herein called the "Contract Price" to be paid by the Owner and accepted by the Contractor for the performance of the work contemplated herein is the lump sum of \$16,067 upon completion of the HVAC systems. Prior to payment, contractor shall present an invoice to the Tazewell County Auditor. Payment will be made through the normal County billing cycle.
- 5. All federal, state and local taxes of all types, included, but not limited to, any excise taxes, taxes upon personal property and sale and use taxes, where applicable, are included in the price as stated herein and whenever required by law, are separately stated.
- 6. Contractor is and shall be an independent contractor for all purposes, solely responsible for the results to be obtained and not subject to the control or supervision of the Owner insofar as the manner and means of performing the services and obligations of this contract.
- 7. In the event the Owner's machinery or equipment is used by the Contractor or any subcontractor in the performance of work called for by the contractor, such machinery or equipment shall be considered as being under the sole custody and control of the Contractor during the period of such use by the Contractor or by any subcontractor, and if any person or persons in the employ of the Owner shall be used to operate such machinery or equipment during the period of such use, such person or persons shall be deemed during such period of operation to be an employee or employees of the Contractor.
- 8. Contractor shall be responsible for damage inflicted by himself or his agents to existing buildings, equipment, or completed new work, which damage results from the performance of Contractor's requirements under this

Agreement. Repair or replacement of all such damaged work shall be done by Contractor at his own expense.

- 9. Contractor shall at all times keep the site, Owner's premises, and adjoining premises, driveways and streets clean of rubbish resulting from such work. At the conclusion of the work, Contractor shall remove all rubbish from and about the premises, as well as all tools, equipment, surplus material, and shall leave the premises clean and ready for use. No burning of rubbish will be permitted on the premises. If Contractor does not perform such cleaning with reasonable promptness or upon request, Owner may cause such cleaning to be done by others and charge the cost of same to Contractor.
- 10. Contractor warrants that all work provided for herein shall be done in a workmanlike manner and all materials provided for herein shall be free from defects and Contractor shall promptly repair or replace any items which are defective in workmanship or materials.
- 11. Contractor shall maintain insurance which will insure the performance by Contractor of the obligations to indemnify and hold harmless, and protect Owner from claims under Workman's Compensation, Occupational Disease Employer's Liability Insurance, Comprehensive General Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage and Automobile Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage. Contractor shall provide to the Tazewell County Auditor, certificates of insurance in a form and amount acceptable to the Tazewell County Auditor which evidences the existence and continuation of the above required insurance.
- Contractor and all subcontractors working on the project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with all the and regulations as given in Williams-Steiger Occupational Safety Health Act of 1970 and all amendments to the Act. Further, Contractor and all subcontractors on the project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with the Prevailing Wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act and its regulations, 29 CFR Parts 1, 3, 5, and 7. Further, Contractor shall pay prevailing wages in accordance with the State of Illinois Prevailing Wage Law, latest revision. All work to be performed hereunder shall be performed in strict accordance with the latest adopted edition of applicable codes regulations.
- 13. Contractor shall save and hold harmless Owner, including its officials, agents and employees, free and harmless from all liability,

- public or private, penalties, contractual or otherwise, attorneys fees, expenses, causes of action, claims or judgments, resulting from claimed injury, damage, loss or loss of use to or of any person, including natural persons and any other legal entity, or property of any kind (including, but not limited to, choses in action) arising out of or in any way connected with the performance of work or work to be performed under this contract, whether or not arising out of the partial or sole negligence of Owner, its officials, agents, or employees, including protection against any claim of the Contractor or any subcontractor for any payments under any Workman's Compensation Insurance carried on behalf of said Contractor or subcontractor and shall indemnify Owner for any costs, expenses, judgments and attorneys fees paid or incurred, by or on behalf of the Owner, and/or its agents and employees, whether or not by or through insurance provided by Owner.
- 14. This Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. All relevant provision of the laws of the State of Illinois applicable hereto and required to be reflected or set forth herein are incorporated herein by reference.
- 15. No waiver of any breach of this contract or any provision hereof shall constitute a waiver of any other breach or further breach of this contract or any provision hereof.
- 16. This contract is severable, and the invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this contract, or any part hereof, shall not render the remainder of this contract invalid or unenforceable.
- 17. This contract may not be assigned or subcontracted by Contractor to any other person or entity without the written consent of Owner.
- 18. This contract shall be binding upon the parties hereto and upon the successors in interest, assigns, representatives and heirs of such parties.
- 19. This contract shall not be amended unless in writing expressly stating that it constitutes an amendment to this contract, signed by the parties hereto. Owner shall not be liable to Contractor for the costs or changes or additions to the work to be performed or the materials to be supplied unless such changes or additions are accepted by Owner in writing approved by and signed by a person with lawful authority granted to execute such writing.

#### AGREEMENT FOR COUNTY OF TAZEWELL

THIS AGREEMENT entered into by and between the County of Tazewell, Illinois, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", and G&B Mechanical, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", effective the 1st day of September, 2011.

WHEREAS, previous heretofore quotes were requested and received for the performance and completion of Quote #2011-04-MechanicalService Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Quote #2011-04-" Mechanical Service Agreement" was received and approved, subject to the execution of this Agreement by the parties hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the herein stated mutual covenants, promises and undertakings by the parties to this Agreement, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. The contract documents consist of this Agreement, contract drawings, specifications, and all addenda issued prior to the execution of this all modifications Agreement and subsequent thereto. These form the contract and are fully a part of this contract as if attached to this agreement or repeated herein. Additionally, and specifically, there is made a part of this Agreement the Quote Sheet # 2011-04 Mechanical Service Agreement, all specifications contained therein, as well as all drawings contained or referred to in the above referenced manual, and all addenda and other documents incorporated in the above referenced contract documents.
- 2. The Contractor shall perform all work required by the contract documents as above described for the Mechanical Service Agreement as described in the above referenced contract documents and in accordance with the said documents, and it is contemplated that the work to be performed under this contract with Tazewell County, Illinois covers and includes, in general, the requirements for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, materials, and services and all other work associated therewith.
- a. Contractor shall provide the Sheriff and the Buildings and Grounds Superintendent with a list of its employees prior to any work being performed. The list shall provide the name, date of birth, social security number, and date of hire for each employee. Contractor shall immediately notify Sheriff of any additions or deletions to such list.

b.Contractor shall comply with all Tazewell County Security Procedures as established by the Sheriff or Presiding Judge. Any breach of such security procedures shall constitute cause to terminate this agreement immediately.

- 3. It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that time is of the essence in the performance of the obligations required hereunder.
- 4. The consideration, herein called the "Contract Price" to be paid by the Owner and accepted by the Contractor for the performance of the work contemplated herein is subject to the terms of the attached Mechanical Service Agreement Quote #2011-04. Prior to payment, contractor shall present a detailed invoice to the Tazewell County Auditor. Payment will be made through the normal County billing cycle.
- 5. All federal, state and local taxes of all types, included, but not limited to, any excise taxes, taxes upon personal property and sale and use taxes, where applicable, are included in the price as stated herein and whenever required by law, are separately stated.
- 6. Contractor is and shall be an independent contractor for all purposes, solely responsible for the results to be obtained and not subject to the control or supervision of the Owner insofar as the manner and means of performing the services and obligations of this contract.
- 7. In the event the Owner's machinery or equipment is used by the Contractor or any subcontractor in the performance of work called for by the contractor, such machinery or equipment shall be considered as being under the sole custody and control of the Contractor during the period of such use by the Contractor or by any subcontractor, and if any person or persons in the employ of the Owner shall be used to operate such machinery or equipment during the period of such use, such person or persons shall be deemed during such period of operation to be an employee or employees of the Contractor.
- 8. Contractor shall be responsible for damage inflicted by himself or his agents to existing buildings, equipment, or completed new

- work, which damage results from the performance of Contractor's requirements under this Agreement. Repair or replacement of all such damaged work shall be done by Contractor at his own expense.
- 9. Contractor shall at all times keep the site, Owner's premises, and adjoining premises, driveways and streets clean of rubbish resulting from such work. At the conclusion of the work, Contractor shall remove all rubbish from and about the premises, as well as all tools, equipment, surplus material, and shall leave the premises clean and ready for use. No burning of rubbish will be permitted on the premises. If Contractor does not perform such cleaning with reasonable promptness or upon request, Owner may cause such cleaning to be done by others and charge the cost of same to Contractor.
- 10. Contractor warrants that all work provided for herein shall be done in a workmanlike manner and all materials provided for herein shall be free from defects and Contractor shall promptly repair or replace any items which are defective in workmanship or materials.
- 11. Contractor shall maintain insurance which will insure the performance by Contractor of the obligations to indemnify and hold harmless, and protect Owner from claims under Workman's Compensation. Occupational Disease Employer's Liability Insurance, Comprehensive General Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage and Automobile Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage. Contractor shall provide to the Tazewell County Auditor, certificates of insurance in a form and amount acceptable to the Tazewell County Auditor which evidences the existence and continuation of the above required insurance.
- 12. Contractor and all subcontractors working on any project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with all the and regulations as given in Williams-Steiger Occupational Safety Health Act of 1970 and all amendments to the Act. Further, Contractor and all subcontractors on the project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with the Prevailing Wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act and its regulations, 29 CFR Parts 1, 3, 5, and 7. Further, Contractor shall pay prevailing wages in accordance with the State of Illinois Prevailing Wage Law, latest revision. All work to be performed hereunder shall be performed in strict accordance with the latest adopted edition of applicable codes and regulations.

- Contractor shall save and hold 13. harmless Owner, including its officials, agents and employees, free and harmless from all liability, public or private, penalties, contractual or otherwise, attorneys fees, expenses, causes of action, claims or judgments, resulting from claimed injury, damage, loss or loss of use to or of any person, including natural persons and any other legal entity, or property of any kind (including, but not limited to, chooses in action) arising out of or in any way connected with the performance of work or work to be performed under this contract, whether or not arising out of the partial or sole negligence of Owner, its officials, agents, or employees, including protection against any claim of the Contractor or any subcontractor for any payments under any Workman's Compensation Insurance carried on behalf of said Contractor or subcontractor and shall indemnify Owner for any costs, expenses, judgments and attorneys fees paid or incurred, by or on behalf of the Owner. and/or its agents and employees, whether or not by or through insurance provided by Owner.
- 14. This Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. All relevant provision of the laws of the State of Illinois applicable hereto and required to be reflected or set forth herein are incorporated herein by reference.
- 15. No waiver of any breach of this contract or any provision hereof shall constitute a waiver of any other breach or further breach of this contract or any provision hereof.
- 16. This contract is severable, and the invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this contract, or any part hereof, shall not render the remainder of this contract invalid or unenforceable.
- 17. This contract may not be assigned or subcontracted by Contractor to any other person or entity without the written consent of Owner.
- 18. This contract shall be binding upon the parties hereto and upon the successors in interest, assigns, representatives and heirs of such parties.
- 19. This contract shall not be amended unless in writing expressly stating that it constitutes an amendment to this contract, signed by the parties hereto. Owner shall not be liable to Contractor for the costs or changes or additions to the work to be performed or the materials to be supplied unless such changes or additions are accepted by Owner in writing approved by and signed by a person with lawful authority granted to execute such writing.
- 20. After the probationary period, this agreement may be terminated upon sixty days

written notice to the other party at such party's business address. Notice shall be deemed given on the date that such notice is placed in the United States mail.

- 21. TERM. The term of this Agreement shall be one year at the same rate of compensation with a one year mutual option at the same rate of compensation, unless terminated as provided in paragraph 20.
- 22. Probationary Term. Contractor agrees that this contract is contingent upon the Property Committee finding that the contractor has satisfactorily performed such services during the initial 90 day period. If in the sole determination of the Property Committee, the Committee finds that contractor's performance is not satisfactory, the Committee may reject this bid and make further recommendation to the Board by either recommending the best remaining qualified bid be accepted or recommending that new bids be solicited. During the probationary period Owner may terminate the agreement at any time upon written notice to Contractor.
- 23. The parties agree that the foregoing document herein referenced constitutes all of the agreement between the parties and in witness thereof the parties have affixed their respective signatures.

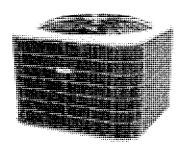

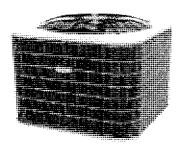

#### INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT

#### WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, pursuant to Division 30 through 39.1 of Chapter 65 (Municipalities) of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the City of East Peoria operates a building code inspection program and employs several building inspectors to carry out said program; and

WHEREAS, the County of Tazewell desires to operate a building code inspection program, but does not employ any individuals qualified to carry out a building code inspection program; and

WHEREAS, after discussion between the parties, the County of Tazewell would like to share or otherwise hire the building code inspection services operated by the City of East Peoria; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois authorizes units of local government to enter into intergovernmental arrangements and agreements or to otherwise associate among themselves in any manner not prohibited by law or ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Section 3 of the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act (5 ILCS 220/3) provides that "[a]ny power or powers, privileges, functions, or authority exercised or which may be exercised by a public agency of this State may be exercised, combined, transferred, and enjoyed jointly with any other public agency of this State;" and

WHEREAS, 5 ILCS 220/2 defines a public agency as "any unit of local government," and the parties of both public agencies as defined by statute; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this agreement is to delineate the logistics by which the County of Tazewell can share the services of the building code inspection Department of the City of East Peoria.

**NOW THEREFORE**, in consideration of the preceding recitals of fact for further considerations, hereinafter stated, **IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS**:

#### 1. Operations.

- a. The County of Tazewell has adopted the following codes and supplements, individually, and collectively as the "building codes" for Tazewell County:
  - i. International Building Code 2006
  - ii. International Existing Building Code 2006
  - iii. International Property Maintenance Code 2006
  - iv. NFPA 70: National Electrical Code 2008 Edition
  - v. State of Illinois Plumbing Code Part 890 Illinois Administrative Code
  - vi. International Mechanical Code 2006
  - vii. 2009 International Energy Conservation Code (state mandated)
  - viii. Environmental Barriers Act (state mandated)
  - ix. Administrative rules as adopted by the State Fire Marshall's Office (state mandated)
- b. The County of Tazewell seeks guidance from the City of East
  Peoria to update building codes, interpret and enforce building
  codes, and assist current and/or future building/zoning officials or
  inspectors with inspections as needed.
- c. Permits and inspections may be required for all new multi-family, multi-family additions, new commercial, commercial additions and industrial that include any electrical, plumbing, sewer, heating, ventilation or air conditioning work on any structure.
- d. Building permit applications and submittals will be reviewed by the designated building/zoning official for the County of Tazewell and the City of East Peoria building official or inspector as needed or as applies.
- c. All building permits will be issued by the designated building/zoning official for the County of Tazewell. The particular requirements for obtaining the necessary building permits are established by the building code as adopted from time to time by the Tazewell County Board.
- f. Building code, electrical, plumbing and HVAC inspections will be provided on an as needed basis. All requests for inspection or advisory/consulting services will be initiated by the designated building/zoning official for the County of Tazewell. Forty-eight (48) hours will be given to the City of East Peoria for necessary inspections.

g. When East Peoria building code inspectors are performing work for the County of Tazewell, they may exercise all building code inspection powers as if they were employed by the County of Tazewell.

#### 2. Rates/Billing.

- a. When inspectors from East Peoria are performing tasks at the request of Tazewell County, services will be billed on an hourly rate.
- b. Services will be billed to Tazewell County on a monthly basis.
- c. Mileage will be included as a part of the hourly rate.
- d. Service begins upon inspectors leaving East Peoria City Hall and ends when they return from inspections for the County.
- e. For the contract period, rates will be as follows: \$57.00/hour, all inspectors

# 3. <u>Nonexclusive Agreement.</u>

- a. This intergovernmental agreement is independent of and in addition to any other contracts or mutual aid agreements between the parties or to which Tazewell County and East Peoria are parties.
- 4. Effective Date/Term/Termination: This agreement shall be in effect on the date it is fully executed by the duly authorized officers of each entity and will remain in effect for the term of six (6) months from the date of execution. Unless terminated in the manner provided for below, it shall automatically renew for successive one year terms. This agreement shall remain in effect until such time as either party to this agreement requests that the terms of the agreement be reviewed and/or a new agreement is executed. Any party hereto may terminate its participation in this agreement at any time, provided that the party that wishes to terminate the agreement provides written notice to the other party specifying the date of termination, such notice to be given at least thirty (30) calendar days prior to the specified date of termination. The written notice provided herein shall be given by personal delivers, registered mail or certified mail.

#### 5. Notices.

All notices hereunder shall be in writing and shall be served personally, by registered mail or certified mail to the parties at such addresses as designated below:

# COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT ASSISTANCE PROGRAM (CDAP) APPLICATION PACKAGING AND SUBMISSION AGREEMENT

This Community Development Assistance Program (CDAP) Application Packaging and Submission Agreement (hereinafter "Agreement") is entered into by and between the County of Tazewell, Illinois (hereinafter "the Applicant") and the Economic Development Council for Central Illinois, Inc., 100 S.W. Water, Peoria, Illinois 61602 (hereinafter "EDC").

The Applicant is interested in obtaining a Program Year (PY) 2011 Flexible Opportunity Community Development Assistance Program (CDAP) grant through the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity (DCEO) for the purpose of undertaking the Tazewell County Resource Center (TCRC) kitchen development project.

EDC, Inc. is a professional, nonprofit economic development organization, whose primary responsibility is to coordinate public and private sector interests for the promotion of new investment, and the creation and/or retention of jobs in the Tri-County Area (Peoria, Tazewell, and Woodford counties). While EDC's primary involvement is with business development and growth, local community development is also seen to be important in attaining EDC's development goals. To this end, EDC has developed excellent working relationships with a variety of state and federal officials, including the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity; the Small Business Administration; and the Illinois Finance Authority.

The County of Tazewell, Illinois in consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, does hereby accept this Agreement, with the terms and conditions as stated below.

- 1) The Chairman of the Board of the County of Tazewell, Illinois, is authorized to execute all necessary documents to fulfill the intent of this Agreement and that a copy of the authorizing resolution is forwarded to EDC.
- 2) EDC is hereby authorized to prepare either an Flexible Opportunity CDAP grant application to fund the construction of the Tazewell County Resource Center (TCRC) kitchen development project. A number of tasks must be completed in order to complete a comprehensive application. The specific tasks are outlined below:
  - A) Set the date for the public hearing. Public notice must be published at least seven days prior the hearing, excluding day of publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the community. EDC will prepare the legal notice for publication and will assist the County with conducting the hearing.
  - B) The County Board must approve a minimum of one resolution but possibly two (2) resolutions for this project: one resolution authorizing the submission of a PY 2011 Flexible Opportunity CDAP grant; whereas, a second resolution may be required to commit the expenditure of matching funds if applicable. All appropriate resolutions must be included in the application.

(The public hearing must be held prior to adopting these resolutions.) EDC will

prepare the draft resolutions.

- C) Preparation of a variety of letters and documents for the completion of the application. EDC will work with DCEO, Tazewell County Health Department, the County Engineer, States Attorney and any other appropriate officials to complete the CDAP application. In addition, EDC will attend all meetings regarding the project, as required by the County Board.
- D) Conducting of an income survey, if necessary, to determine the number and percent of "low- and moderate-income" persons in order to establish the Applicant's eligibility for the program;
- E) Compilation and printing of the CDAP application will be done by EDC. Furthermore, EDC will deliver the application to Springfield. (In addition to the required applications submitted to DCEO, the County will also receive a copy of the application.)
- 3) Application costs incurred by EDC will be paid by applicant. Only time and expenses directly attributable to the actual writing and coordination and submittal of the application will be allowable. EDC will invoice Applicant for such time and expenses in the amount of Two Thousand Two Hundred Dollars and No Cents (\$2,200.00) for the application.
- 4) Legal, engineering, and other professional costs incurred as a result of the application will be the sole responsibility of Applicant. EDC will not be responsible for the material that cannot be obtained in a timely manner from outside service providers.
- 5) If any provision of this Agreement is deemed invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such validation will not render invalid other provisions of this Agreement, which can remain in effect without the specified invalid provision
- 6) This agreement will be construed in accordance with the Laws and Constitution of the State of Illinois.
- 7) This agreement will become effective upon execution of said Agreement by Applicant and EDC.
- 8) EDC represents and warrants that its execution, delivery, and performance of this Agreement have been duly authorized by all necessary corporate and other actions and is valid upon EDC's execution.
- 9) EDC does not represent and warrant that this Agreement will insure that the Illinois Department of Commerce and Economic Opportunity will approve said application.

Each party hereto may execute an identical counterpart of this Agreement and all such

In consideration of the provisions provided herein, Tazewell County and Hopedale Medical Complex agree to enter into an agreement for discounted charges for Tazewell County employees and their dependents utilizing the services of Hopedale Medical Complex as part of Tazewell County's health insurance program. Any prior agreements on reimbursement discounts between Tazewell County and Hopedale Medical Complex are void and replaced upon the execution of this agreement.

- 1. Inpatient Reimbursement of Covered Expenses: A discount of 20% shall be applied to all charges. For inpatient claims exceeding \$10,000 in charges, an additional 5% discount shall be applied if paid within 35 days of submission of a clean claim.
- 2. Outpatient Reimbursement of Covered Expenses: A discount of 30% shall be applied to all charges.
- 3. This agreement shall take effect for claims paid on or after September 1, 2010 and terminate on September 1, 2013, unless extended by mutual consent of both parties.
- 4. If Hopedale Medical Complex raises its charges in excess of 3%, Tazewell County shall have the right to renegotiate this agreement.
- 5. Hopedale Medical Complex recognizes that Tazewell County has an exclusive agreement with Methodist Medical Center of Illinois for hospital services in Peoria County and that Tazewell County pays 0% at any other hospital in Peoria County. #### AGREEMENT FOR COUNTY OF TAZEWELL

THIS AGREEMENT entered into by and between the County of Tazewell, Illinois, a body politic and corporate, hereinafter referred to as "Owner", and Mark Bale & Son Concrete Construction, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor", effective the 1st day of September, 2011.

WHEREAS, previous heretofore quotes were received for the performance and completion of the Courthouse sidewalk replacement; and

WHEREAS, the quote from Mark Bale and Son Concrete Construction was received and approved, subject to the execution of this Agreement by the parties hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the herein stated mutual covenants, promises and undertakings by the parties to this Agreement, it is agreed by and between the parties as follows:

- 1. The contract documents consist of this Agreement, contract drawings, specifications, and all addenda issued prior to the execution of this Agreement and all modifications subsequent thereto. These form the contract and are fully a part of this contract as if attached to this agreement or repeated herein. Additionally, and specifically, there is made a part of this Agreement the Mark Bale & Son Concrete proposal dated 7/21/11, all specifications contained therein, as well as all drawings contained or referred to in the above referenced manual, and all addenda and other documents incorporated in the above referenced contract documents.
- 2. The Contractor shall perform all work required by the contract documents as described in the above referenced contract documents and in accordance with the said documents, and it is contemplated that the work to be performed under this contract with Tazewell County, Illinois covers and includes, in general, the requirements for the furnishing of all labor, equipment, materials, and services and all other work associated therewith.
- a. Contractor shall provide the Sheriff with a list of its employees prior to any work being performed. The list shall provide the name, date of birth, social security number, and date of hire for each employee. Contractor shall immediately notify Sheriff of any additions or deletions to such list

b.Contractor shall comply with all Tazewell County Security Procedures as established by the Sheriff or Presiding Judge. Any breach of such security procedures shall constitute cause to terminate this agreement immediately.

- 3. It is agreed by and between the parties hereto that time is of the essence in the performance of the obligations required hereunder.
- 4. The consideration, herein called the "Contract Price" to be paid by the Owner and accepted by the Contractor for the performance of the work contemplated herein is \$5,448 for the base bid plus additional concrete work as requested at the rate of \$6.50 per square foot with the combined total not to exceed \$7,500. Prior to payment, contractor shall present an invoice to the Tazewell County Auditor. Payment will be made through the normal County billing cycle.
- 5. All federal, state and local taxes of all types, included, but not limited to, any excise taxes, taxes upon personal property and sale and use taxes, where applicable, are included in the price as stated herein and whenever required by law, are separately stated.
- 6. Contractor is and shall be an independent contractor for all purposes, solely responsible for the results to be obtained and not subject to the control or supervision of the Owner insofar as the manner and means of performing the services and obligations of this contract.
- 7. In the event the Owner's machinery or equipment is used by the Contractor or any subcontractor in the performance of work called for by the contractor, such machinery or equipment shall be considered as being under the sole custody and control of the Contractor during the period of such use by the Contractor or by any subcontractor, and if any person or persons in the employ of the Owner shall be used to operate such machinery or equipment during the period of such use, such person or persons shall be deemed during such period of operation to be an employee or employees of the Contractor.
- 8. Contractor shall be responsible for damage inflicted by himself or his agents to existing buildings, equipment, or completed new work, which damage results from the performance of Contractor's requirements under this Agreement. Repair or replacement of all such

damaged work shall be done by Contractor at his own expense.

- 9. Contractor shall at all times keep the site, Owner's premises, and adjoining premises, driveways and streets clean of rubbish resulting from such work. At the conclusion of the work, Contractor shall remove all rubbish from and about the premises, as well as all tools, equipment, surplus material, and shall leave the premises clean and ready for use. No burning of rubbish will be permitted on the premises. If Contractor does not perform such cleaning with reasonable promptness or upon request, Owner may cause such cleaning to be done by others and charge the cost of same to Contractor.
- 10. Contractor warrants that all work provided for herein shall be done in a workmanlike manner and all materials provided for herein shall be free from defects and Contractor shall promptly repair or replace any items which are defective in workmanship or materials.
- 11. Contractor shall maintain insurance which will insure the performance by Contractor of the obligations to indemnify and hold harmless. and protect Owner from claims under Workman's Compensation, Occupational Disease Employer's Liability Insurance, Comprehensive General Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage and Automobile Liability Insurance including bodily injury and property damage. Contractor shall provide to the Tazewell County Auditor, certificates of insurance in a form and amount acceptable to the Tazewell County Auditor which evidences the existence and continuation of the above required insurance.
- 12, Contractor and all subcontractors working on the project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with all the rules and regulations as given in Williams-Steiger Occupational Safety Health Act of 1970 and all amendments to the Act. Further, Contractor and all subcontractors on the project at the job site during the term of this Agreement shall comply with the Prevailing Wage requirements of the Davis-Bacon Act and its regulations, 29 CFR Parts 1, 3, 5, and 7. Further, Contractor shall pay prevailing wages in accordance with the State of Illinois Prevailing Wage Law, latest revision. All work to be performed hereunder shall be performed in strict accordance with the latest adopted edition of applicable codes regulations.
- 13. Contractor shall save and hold harmless Owner, including its officials, agents and employees, free and harmless from all liability, public or private, penalties, contractual or

- otherwise, attorneys fees, expenses, causes of action, claims or judgments, resulting from claimed injury, damage, loss or loss of use to or of any person, including natural persons and any other legal entity, or property of any kind (including, but not limited to, choses in action) arising out of or in any way connected with the performance of work or work to be performed under this contract, whether or not arising out of the partial or sole negligence of Owner, its officials, agents, or employees, including protection against any claim of the Contractor or any subcontractor for any payments under any Workman's Compensation Insurance carried on behalf of said Contractor or subcontractor and shall indemnify Owner for any costs, expenses, judgments and attorneys fees paid or incurred, by or on behalf of the Owner, and/or its agents and employees, whether or not by or through insurance provided by Owner.
- 14. This Contract shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois. All relevant provision of the laws of the State of Illinois applicable hereto and required to be reflected or set forth herein are incorporated herein by reference.
- 15. No waiver of any breach of this contract or any provision hereof shall constitute a waiver of any other breach or further breach of this contract or any provision hereof.
