WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor was created to provide services to State's Attorneys in Judicial Districts containing less than 3,000,000 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the powers and duties of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are defined and enumerated in the "State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's Act", 725 ILCS 210/1 et.seg. as amended; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois General Assembly appropriates monies for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, one-third from the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor's County Fund and two-thirds from the General Revenue Fund, provided that such funding receives county approval and support from within the respective Judicial Districts eligible to apply; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor shall administer the operation of the appellate offices so as to insure that all participating State's Attorneys continue to have final authority in preparation, filing, and arguing of all appellate briefs and any trial assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor and the Illinois General Assembly have reviewed and approved a budget for Fiscal Year 2011, which funds will provide for the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Tazewell County Board in regular session, this 16th day of November, 2011 does hereby support the continued operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and designates the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor as its Agent to administer the operation of the appellate offices and process said appellate court cases for this County.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor are hereby authorized to act as Assistant State's Attorneys on behalf of the State's Attorneys of this county in the appeal of all cases, when requested to so by the State's Attorney, and with the advice and consent of the State's Attorney prepare, file, and argue appellate briefs for those cases; and also, as may be requested by the State's Attorney, to assist in the prosecution of cases under the Illinois Controlled Substances Act, the Cannabis Control Act, the Drug Asset Forfeiture Procedure Act and the Narcotics Profit Forfeiture Act. Such attorneys are further authorized to assist the State's Attorney in the State's Attorney's duties under the Illinois Public Labor Relations Act, including negotiations thereunder, as well as in the trial and appeal of tax objections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the attorneys employed by the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor may also assist the State's Attorney of this County in the discharge of the State's Attorney's duties in the prosecution and trial of other cases, and may act as Special Prosecutor if duly appointed to do so by a court having jurisdiction.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tazewell County Board hereby agrees to participate in the service program of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor for Fiscal Year 2012, commencing December 1, 2011, and ending November 30, 2012, by hereby appropriating the sum of \$27,000.00 for the express purpose of providing a portion of the funds required for financing the operation of the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor, and agrees to deliver the same to the Office of the State's Attorneys Appellate Prosecutor on request during the Fiscal Year 2012.

SERVICES AGREEMENT

Professional Energy Consulting Services

This Services Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into and effective on this 26th day of September, 2011 ("Effective Date") by and between Tazewell County, Illinois ("Tazewell County"), an Illinois body politic, with offices located at 11 S. 4th Street, Pekin, Illinois 61554 and Good Energy, L.P. ("Service Provider"), with an office and principal place of business located at 232 Madison Avenue, Suite 405, New York, NY 10016.

Recitals

WHEREAS, Tazewell County desires to engage Service Provider to perform electricity consultancy services and procurement for Tazewell County residential and small commercial electric accounts.

WHEREAS, Services Provider desires to perform the Services and desires to be so engaged.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing and of the covenants and agreements herein contained, the parties, intending to be legally bound, agree as follows:

Provisions

I. Performance of the Services. Provider shall:

- A. Provide the following services:
 - 1. Electricity Residential opt-out consulting services
 - 2. Marketing services for opt-out electricity aggregation program and associates costs to perform awareness campaign
 - 3. Coordinating efforts with the Illinois Commerce Commission
 - 4. Attending public hearings with the County and other municipal partners
 - 5. Bid creation and execution with multiple electricity suppliers with final selection of an electric supplier being decided by Tazewell County
 - 6. Negotiating fees for the County with winning suppliers in an amount equal to or greater than the rate negotiated for Good Energy, L.P.
 - 7. After purchase program delivery and on-going daily monitoring,
- В. Give prompt notice to Tazewell County should the Service Provider observe or otherwise become aware of any fault or deficit in the project or any nonconformance with the electricity sale & purchase agreement.
- C. Remit to Tazewell County after the termination of this Agreement, all files and documents pertaining to the project that have been obtained or produced including, but not limited to, permits, licenses, applications, codes, drawings, site plans, photographs and similar materials.
- Đ. Comply with all statutes, ordinances, laws, rules and regulations which may be applicable to the services provided hereunder.

II. **Obligations of Tazewell County.** Tazewell County shall:

- Assist the Service Provider by placing at its disposal all public information pertinent to A. the services for the project, upon reasonable request.
- В. Make all necessary provisions allowable by law to enter upon public and private property as required to perform the Services.
- C. Make reasonable provisions to enter upon public property as required to perform the services.
- D. Give prompt notice to the Service Provider should Tazewell County observe or otherwise become aware of any fault or deficit in the project or any nonconformance with the Agreement.
- III. ____ day of Term and Termination. The Agreement shall commence on the 2011 and shall terminate on the 30th day of October, 2014, or as otherwise mutually agreed to by Tazewell County and the Service Provider. Tazewell County may terminate this Agreement at any time by giving Service Provider thirty (30) days advance written notice. In the event this Agreement is terminated by Tazewell County prior to its natural expiration, Service Provider shall be paid the term of electricity purchased through the residential small commercial opt-out contract by the current alternative supplier. Tazewell County shall have no obligation under this agreement to provide any compensation or payment of any kind to Good Energy, to an electricity supplier or to any other party.

IV. Payment.

Tazewell County agrees that Good Energy fees will be paid by the selected electricity supplier per kWh (volumetrically) for electricity purchased for the duration of the municipal contract. Fees paid by the selected electricity supplier shall be subject to the mutual agreement of Tazewell County and Good Energy. Tazewell County shall have no obligation under this agreement to provide any compensation or payment of any kind to Good Energy, to an electricity supplier or to any other party.

V. Relationship of the Parties. The parties acknowledge and agree that Service Provider is an independent contractor and is not an agent or employee of Tazewell County. Nothing in this Agreement shall be construed to create a relationship between Service Provider and Tazewell County of a partnership, association, or joint venture.

VI. Indemnification.

- Professional Liability. Relative to any and all claims, losses, damages, liability and cost, A. the Service Provider agrees to indemnify and save Tazewell County, its officers, officials, and employees harmless from and against any and all suits, actions or claims for property losses, damages or personal injury claimed to arise from a negligent act, error or omission by the Service Provider or its employees.
- В. Non-Professional Liability (General Liability). To the fullest extent permitted by law, the Service Provider shall indemnify, defend and hold harmless Tazewell County, its officers, officials, employees or any combination thereof, from and against claims,

damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to attorneys' fees, arising out of the acts or omissions of the Service Provider, provided that such claim, damage, loss or expenses is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury to or destruction of property (other than the work itself) including loss of use resulting therefrom, but only to the extent caused to in whole or in part by the acts or omissions of the Service Provider, any subconsultant(s) of the Service Provider, its against, or anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, regardless of whether or not such claim damage, loss or expense is caused in part by a party indemnified hereunder. Such obligations shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or reduce other rights or obligations of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to a party or person described in this paragraph.

VII. Insurance.

- The Service Provider shall secure and maintain, at his/her/its own expense, errors and Α. omissions insurance in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per claim/annual aggregate to protect himself from any claim arising out of the performance of professional services and caused by negligent acts, omissions or negligent acts for which the Service Provider may be legally negligent. The Service Provider shall maintain said coverage for the entire contract period and for a minimum of one year after completion of the work under the contract.
- В. In addition to errors and omissions insurance, the Service Provider shall also secure and maintain, at his/her own expense, insurance for protection from claims under Worker's Compensation acts, claims for damages because of bodily injury including personal injury, sickness or disease or death of any and all employees or of any person other than such employees, and from claims or damages because of injury to or destruction of property including loss of use resulting therefrom, and any other insurance prescribed by laws, rules, regulations, ordinances, codes or orders.
- C. The Service Provider shall secure and maintain, at his/her own expense, General Liability insurance in an amount not less than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000.00) per occurrence.
- D. The Service Provider shall secure and maintain, at his/her/its own expense, Property insurance for protection from claims or damages because of damage to or destruction of property including loss of use resulting therefrom in an amount not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00). Tazewell County shall be held harmless for any damage to the Service Provider's property and/or equipment during the course of performance under the Contract.
- E. The above referenced insurance shall be maintained in full force and effect during the life of this Contract and for one year beyond, where specified. Certificates showing that the Service Provider is carrying the above referenced insurance in at least the above specified minimum amounts shall be furnished to, and approved by, Tazewell County prior to the start of work on the project and before Tazewell County is obligated to make any payments to the Service Provider for the work performed under the provision of this contract. All such Certificates, with the exception of those for Worker's Compensation and Errors & Omissions coverage, shall clearly reflect that Tazewell County is an "Additional Insured".

VIII. Right to Audit

- A. Service Provider guarantees that the individuals employed by the Service Provider in any capacity, including but not limited to, employees, subcontractors and independent contractors, are authorized to work in the United States. The Service Provider represents that it has completed the I-9 verification process for all individuals the Service Provider has performing services for Tazewell County. Tazewell County maintains the right to audit the Form I-9s for all individuals the Service Provider has performing services for Tazewell County every six (6) months. Tazewell County will provide the Service Provider with five (5) days advanced written notice of its intent to perform a Form I-9 audit. In response to Tazewell County's audit request, the Service Provider shall provide copies of all Form I-9s and any supporting documentation for all individuals who the Service Provider had performing services for Tazewell County at any time subsequent to the date upon which Tazewell County gave notice of the preceding Form I-9 audit.
- В. The Service Provider agrees to indemnify Tazewell County in accordance with Section VI of the Agreement for any issue arising out of the Service Provider's hiring or retention of any individual who is not authorized to work in the United States.

IX. Taxes.

- A. Service Provider has the following identification number for income tax purposes: 43-2003973.
- B. Service Provider is subject to and responsible for all applicable federal, state, and local
- C. Tazewell County represents that it is a tax-exempt entity and evidence of this tax-exempt status shall be provided to Service Provider upon written request. Service Provider hereby further agrees to withhold all municipal income taxes due or payable under the provisions of the Codified Ordinances of Tazewell County, Illinois, for wages, salaries and commissions paid to its employees and further agrees that any of its subcontractors shall be required to agree to withhold any such municipal income taxes due under such chapter for Services performed under this Agreement.
- X. Assignment. Neither party may assign this Agreement without obtaining express, written consent from the other party prior to assignment.
- XI. Entire Agreement / Amendment. This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding of the parties hereto with respect to the subject matter hereof and supersedes all prior negotiations, discussions, undertakings and agreements between the parties. It is understood and agreed that this Agreement may not be changed, modified, or altered except by an instrument, in writing, signed by both parties in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois.

XII. Discrimination.

A. No discrimination for reason of race, religion, sex, age or country of national origin shall be permitted or authorized by Tazewell County and/or Service Provider in connection with the Services.

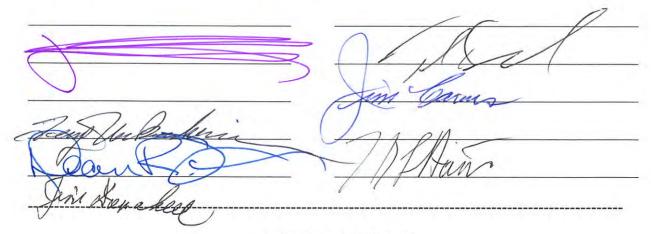
- B. Nothing in this Agreement shall require the commission of any act contrary to any law or any rules or regulations of any union, guild, or similar body having jurisdiction over the Services of Service Provider.
- XIII. Governing Law/Venue. - XV. Paragraph Headings. Paragraph headings are inserted in this Agreement for convenience only and are not to be used in interpreting this Agreement.

Services:

Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control Administrator Agreement

THIS AGREEMENT entered into as of the 1st day of December, 2011 by and between the County of Tazewell a body politic and corporate, (hereinafter referred to as the "County"), and Arthur Herm, D.V.M., (hereinafter referred to as "Administrator):

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, Administrator is a Veterinarian licensed by the State of Illinois to engage in the practice of Veterinary Medicine; and

WHEREAS, the County and the Administrator wish to enter into an Agreement which will effectively carryout certain of the mandates set forth in the Illinois Animal Control Act, that same being ILCS 510 5/1 et seq. (1983);

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the hereinafter stated mutual covenants, promises, and agreement herein contained, the parties agree hereto as follows:

DEFINITIONS

Administrator is hereby hired to serve as Administrator of the Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control program. For purposes of definition, "Administrator" means a Veterinarian licensed by the State of Illinois and who is appointed pursuant to this Act to perform the hereafter specified functions. It is contemplated by the parties hereto that the Administrator shall be responsible for the performance of certain specified function delineated here which shall be performed by Robert Marshall, Director of Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control, who shall be considered, in accordance with the Illinois Animal Control Act, as the duly authorized representative of the Administrator of the execution and functions and purposes provided for in the Illinois Animal Control Act.

DUTIES OF THE ADMINISTRATOR

The following shall constitute the duties of the Administrator:

- A. Inspect and make examination as needed on a regular basis of animals present upon the premises and determine the degree of cleanliness of the Kennels and state of health and welfare of animals upon the premises. It is contemplated that Holidays and weekend examinations shall be done only on an emergency basis.
- B. With respect to the examination of sick and/or injured animals at the Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control facility, the Administrator shall make recommendations for their care. The actual treatment and care may be attended to by other Animal & Rabies Control personnel where possible.

- C. Make recommendations concerning the Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control facility medical program. Actual implementation of said recommendations shall be performed by other Animal Control personnel, where possible, under the supervision of the Administrator.
- D. Control the disposition of diseased and unclaimed animals through euthanasia. It is understood that the actual euthanization of animals may be performed by other Animal Control personnel, where possible.
- E. When the Administrator or the Animal Control Director receives information that any person has been bitten by a dog or other animal, the Administrator or his authorized representatives (Animal Control & Rabies personnel) shall have such dog or other animal confined under the observation of a licensed veterinarian for a period of ten (10) days, or as otherwise provided for by the Department of Agriculture regulations. The Administrator, or his authorized representatives, in the absence of the Administrator, shall further attend to and execute the duties as contained in Paragraph 1 of the Illinois Animal Control Act in reference to reports of bites by other dogs or other animals.
- F. Attend to the inoculation or vaccination of animals, as required by law. It is recognized by the parties that said inoculation or vaccination may be performed by other personnel of the Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control facility.

DUTIES AND AUTHORITY COMMITTED TO THE DIRECTOR OF TAZEWELL COUNTY ANIMAL & RABIES CONTROL

The Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control Director shall have the following authority and duties:

- A. Prepare and control the Animal Control budget.
- B. Assure that the buildings and equipment at Tazewell County Animal & Rabies Control are maintained in a safe and useable condition.
- C. Enforce established procedures and laws pertaining to bite cases, rabid animals, use of County equipment, and issuance of citations for prosecution.
- D. Prepare and record data on all animal bite cases which are reported to County.
- E. Negotiate agreements with Tazewell County municipalities regarding fees for patrols and pick-up of animals.
- F. Perform clerical functions and oversee clerical functions performed by other employees, such as computer inputting, typing, filing, posting, answering animal control injuries via telephone or in person regarding tags and vaccinations.

- G. Prepare monthly bills and reports for both Animal Control activities and municipalities according to contractual agreement.
- H. Maintain and update files on wolf-mix dogs, bite cases, etc. pertaining to the issuance of vaccination papers and tags.
- I. Collect, record, issue receipts, and prepare bank deposits for all money received through Animal & Rabies Control.
- J. Implement the needs of the Animal Control Administrator.
- K. Train new employees.
- L. Administer and supervise the duties of all employees in the Animal & Rabies Control Department.
- M. Report to the County Board Chairman, as well as the Chairman of Health Services Committee regarding problems or recommendations.

INSURANCE

The Administrator agrees that he shall obtain malpractice insurance at his own expense, which shall indemnify and hold harmless both he and the County of Tazewell for any and all liability as a result of his performance under this agreement.

The Administrator further agrees that the insurance policy, referenced above, shall have an upper limit of \$300,000 per occurrence.

A Certificate of Insurance or other evidence of said insurance policy shall be filed with the Tazewell County Board Office.

TERMS OF AGREEMENT

This contract shall remain in full force and effect, unless terminated earlier, for a period of one (1) year from the date of execution hereof. At the expiration of six (6) months from the day of execution of this agreement, the parties shall review the provisions provided for hereinafter for compensation in order to make an adjustment in the amount of compensation as may be agreed to by and between the parties.

COMPENSATION

In consideration of the services to be provided by the Administrator in pursuant to this agreement, the Administrator shall be paid the sum of \$1,816.67 per month. Compensation shall be paid to the Administrator in accordance with the Tazewell County billing cycle pursuant to the Illinois Prompt Payment Act. The Administrator shall have no right, title, interest or claim to future or further payments until subsequent to the

performance of the duties provided for hereunder during the course of any month, or portion thereof.

INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

The parties hereto agree that the Administrator is an Independent Contractor and not and employee of Tazewell County, and nothing contained in this agreement shall constitute or designate the Administrator as an employee of the County.

ASSIGNMENT

It is the specific intent and understanding between the parties hereto that this agreement is for personal services to be supplied by the Administrator. Any attempt by the Administrator to assign the service to be rendered hereunder without the specific written consent of the County shall be considered to be and shall constitute notice to the County of termination pursuant to the paragraph herein above entitled "TERMS OF AGREEMENT" with the further understanding that any such assignment shall be deemed to be an immediate termination without any ten (10) day written notice needed to have given.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 7, CHAPTER 1, ZONING-CODE OF TAZEWELL COUNTY ON PETITION OF WAYNE AND MARJORIE COUNTERMAN, RANDALL COUNTERMAN, CHARLES HUNDT, RONALD HUNDT, AND MARY AND KRISTINA LYNN

(Zoning Board Case No. 11-57-Z)

WHEREAS, a petition has been filed with the County Clerk of Tazewell County, Illinois, By Wayne and Marjorie Counterman, Randall Counterman, Charles Hundt, Ronald Hundt, and Mary and Kristina Lynn for an Amendment to the Official Zoning Maps of Tazewell County to change the Zoning Classification of property from an A-1 Agriculture Preservation District to a R-R Rural Residential District; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on said application designated as Zoning Board Case No. 11-57-Z as held by the Tazewell County Zoning Board of Appeals on November 1, 2011, following due publication of notice of said hearing in accordance with law, and the said Zoning Board of Appeals thereafter made a report to the County Board recommending approval; and

WHEREAS, said report to the Zoning Board of Appeals contained the following findings of fact:

- 1. The proposed amendment shall not be detrimental to the orderly development of Tazewell County.
 - POSITIVE. The proposed amendment is for this property to be placed within the Rural Residential Zoning District. This request encompasses seven different properties located among wooded, hilly terrain with some water features; five of the properties contain dwellings. Other dwellings are located among wooded land to the north and across Mennonite Church Road, and only a very small portion of the acreage is used for agriculture. Because dwellings exist on the subject properties and within the general area, the land is largely hilly and wooded, and very little land is used for agriculture, the proposed amendment will not be detrimental to the orderly development of Tazewell County.
- 2. The proposed amendment shall not be detrimental to or endanger the public health, safety, morals or general welfare of Tazewell County.
 - POSITIVE. The immediate area is hilly and wooded, and dwellings are located on some of the subject properties and within the general area. Very little of the subject land is used for agriculture. Therefore, the proposed rezoning will better reflect the existing uses on the subject properties, so the proposed amendment will not be detrimental to the public health, safety, morals or general welfare.

3. The request is consistent with existing uses of property within the general area of the property in question.

POSITIVE. Most of the properties in question contain dwellings, and other residential uses are located to the north and across Mennonite Church Road. The immediate area is largely wooded and used for residential purposes; very little of the land is used for agriculture. Therefore, the request is consistent with existing uses of property within the general area.

4. The request is consistent with the zoning classifications of property within the general area of the property in question.

POSITIVE. All adjacent property is zoned A-1, and some property within the general area to the south is zoned R-1 for denser residential uses. However, the subject properties are located in a hilly wooded area, and most of the properties are already used for residential purposes. Very little of the subject land is used for agriculture. Therefore, the request is judged to be consistent with the zoning classifications of property within the general area.

5. The suitability of the property in question for the uses permitted under the existing zoning classification.

POSITIVE. The existing A-1 zoning classification primarily allows for agricultural uses and has a minimum lot size of 40 acres, but the subject properties in general are used for residential purposes and have smaller lot sizes. The majority of the land is not suitable for agriculture. Therefore, the property is not suitable for the uses permitted under the existing zoning classification.

6. The suitability of the property in question for the uses permitted under the proposed zoning classification.

POSITIVE. The proposed RR zoning classification allows for residential uses on a minimum lot size of 2 acres, and the subject properties generally are developed for residential purposes. Three of the subject properties are less than 2 acres in size and two of the subject properties are between 2 acres and 3 acres in size. The majority of the property is developed for residential use or is suitable for residential use. Therefore, the property is suitable for uses permitted under the proposed zoning classification.

7. The trend of development, if any, in the general area of the property in question, including changes, if any, which may have taken place since the property in question was placed in its present zoning classification.

POSITIVE. The trend of development in the general area has been toward residential uses. The immediate area is wooded and hilly, and five of the seven subject properties contain dwellings. Also, only a very small portion of the subject property is used for agriculture. Therefore, the trend of development supports the proposed rezoning.

8. The length of time the property has been vacant as zoned, considered in the context of the land development in the area surrounding the subject property.

POSITIVE. The property is vacant as zoned because although it is zoned for agricultural use, it is generally not suitable for agriculture. The subject property is largely hilly and wooded, and five of the seven subject properties have been developed for residential purposes. Also, only a very small portion of the subject property is used for agriculture. Therefore, the proposed rezoning is suitable.

9. The proposed map amendment is within one and one half $(1 \frac{1}{2})$ miles of a municipality and consistent with an adopted Comprehensive Plan.

POSITIVE. The proposed map amendment is within one-and-one-half miles of Pekin, and according to the Pekin Comprehensive Plan, land within this general area is slated to be used for conservation purposes and estate purposes in the future. Because the land in general is already developed for residential use and it is near land slated to be used for estate purposes, the proposed map amendment is consistent with the Pekin Comprehensive Plan.

10. The relative gain to the public as compared to the hardship imposed upon the individual property owner.

POSITIVE. Allowing the current zoning classification to remain will impose a hardship on the property owners because the subject property is not suitable for the current zoning classification due to its existing characteristics and the existing development. This situation could prevent changes to the properties that would be appropriate based on the existing manner in which the properties are used. Therefore, the proposed zoning amendment is suitable.

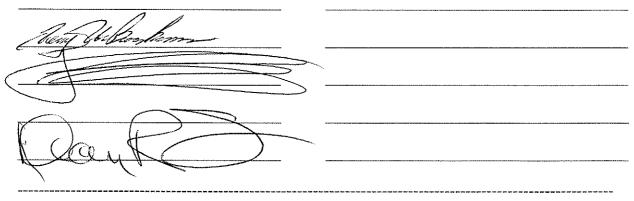
