## AGREEMENT FOR REINSTATEMENT OF THE CONTRACT FOR SERVICES BETWEEN VONACHEN SERVICES, INC. AND THE COUNTY OF TAZEWELL

This reinstatement agreement (hereinafter "reinstatement") is entered into this day, Lept 38 40, 2016 between Vonachen Services, Inc. (hereinafter "VSI") and the County of Tazewell (hereinafter "County"), a body politic and corporate.

WHEREAS, on the 3rd day of April, 2014, VSI and the County entered into a contract for cleaning services titled "Agreement For County of Tazewell" which was extended for a period of 12 months on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April, 2016, and
