The purpose of the hearing is to allow the public an opportunity to comment on the upcoming reapportionment/redistricting for purposes of Tazewell County Board representation. Consideration of new district boundaries for County Board election purposes follows each Decennial Census. A decision on an apportionment plan could come as soon as July 2021.
